THE VICAR'S VOICE: **Strategic planning.**

As a parish, we are committed to continuing to grow in our Christian discipleship and in our witness to the communities in which we are placed. To help us do this, we undertake regular evaluations of the life of the parish, helping us identify areas where we have particular strengths, and those in which we could do better. As part of this process, Parish Council has agreed to use the Natural Church Development Survey, which will give us a snapshot of parish life, and help us to identify the areas we need to work on, and the resources we already have with which to begin that work. We have invited a representative group of 30 members of the parish to complete the survey. Once the results have been processed, we will begin a discussion process involving the whole parish to help us discern how this information can inform our planning for the next few years of our life together. *Jill*
